ICA Biodiversity Challenge

For the second year in a row, Geisenheim University is participating in the ICA Biodiversity Challenge/BioBlitz from May 2nd to June 28th, 2024, as a member of the "Association for European Life Science Universities" (ICA).

A BioBlitz is an attempt to count the number of species found on campus. Everyone can participate and enter species into the Observation.org, Obsidentify, or Obsmapp apps. The number of species registered in the app can be tracked in real-time. In addition, the progress of other participating institutions can be followed live.

This dedicates us to the important topic of biodiversity on and around the university campus in the form of an interactive participation action for students, staff, and residents. Together with many helping hands, Geisenheim University achieved 7th place in the ranking in 2023. In total, 744 species were identified, so the goal for 2024 is clear: This year we want to improve our result from last year and maybe even break the mark of 1000 species.

News from around the world

Switzerland convicted for inadequate climate protection measures

The European Court of Human Rights (ECHR) has for the first time convicted a country for inadequate climate protection. The Strasbourg court ruled in favor of a group of Swiss seniors who accuse their government of violating their human rights through inadequate climate protection. Switzerland must now review its climate protection policy. Climate activists hope for a signaling effect for other countries, although further complaints from France and Portugal have already been directed by the ECHR. According to independent scientists, no country can currently meet the requirements of the Paris Agreement to limit global warming to below 2°C. Here is the mdr article on the topic.

Anniversary Day "Vision Democracy" at Niederwald (Rüdesheim am Rhein)

In the year of the 75th anniversary of the Basic Law, the Society for the Study of Democracy History (GEDG) has chosen the Niederwald Hunting Lodge as a stop on its "Tour de Democracy." The tour spans approximately 20 stations from May 4th to May 25th, 2024, from Weimar to Bonn. Along the way, the journey is supported by a variety of associations and institutions that transport the relay baton using various means of transportation on roads,

railways, and waterways. On May 15th, the project group will arrive at the Niederwald Hunting Lodge by ship and cable car. This location hosted important meetings of the state premiers in 1948 to draft the Basic Law of the Federal Republic of Germany.

To mark this occasion, the State Castles and Gardens of Hesse offer stimulating lectures for discussing and reflecting on democracy, musical accompaniment, as well as food and drink on May 15, 2024.
